Fire safety system

Each residence building is equipped with a centrally controlled fire safety system that is connected to 24-hr monitoring. Suites are protected by heat-activated sprinklers (as required by the British Columbia Building Code), smoke detectors (as per code) and alarm sirens; all common areas and parking garages are similarly protected.

Policy on portable electrical appliances, smoking and open flames

Found in the Community Living Guide - This document is distributed to each student, required to be signed off on by the student, and updated annually.

Evacuation Procedures

Posted in every residence building as per British Columbia Building Code. The procedure is also outlined in the Community Living Guide, is distributed to each student, required to be signed off on by the student, and updated annually.

Fire Safety Education/Training Programs

All Residence Village Advisors and the Residence Council are trained as required by government standards with respect to fire safety and response procedures.

Fire Reporting Procedure

A student in residence would report a fire to their Floor Representative or Village Advisor/Staff or Faculty in Residence, whichever is most accessible at the time. If not already notified through the fire safety system, Campus Security would also be notified. This information would then be passed on to the Director of Facilities/Fire Safety Director, Dean of Students and VP Operations.
