

## Seasonal Groundskeeper

## **Summary of Responsibilities:**

Reporting to the Facilities Team Leader, the Groundskeeper will ensure all outdoor gardens, lawns, trees and walkways are well maintained and is also responsible for any larger scale landscaping projects if required. Workers are expected to follow instruction from the team lead and will need to be able to work unsupervised while maintaining a quick pace. At times in the summer, the Groundskeeper may be asked to work on other facilities teams. Please note workers are expected to use some specialized tools and will be trained accordingly. These tools consist of but are not limited to lawn mowers, paint sprayers, golf carts, battery operated drills/saws/angle grinders as well as a myriad of other gas powered, electrical powered and pneumatic devices. A current BC license is preferred but not an absolute requirement.

## **Qualifications:**

Strong work ethic, punctuality and ability to perform physical labour for an extended period of time. Must be able to work cooperatively in a team environment, take direction and carry out assigned tasks. Willingness to perform a wide range of facility tasks. Experience in landscaping/groundskeeping is an asset, but is not required.

<u>Schedule/Pay:</u> 35 hours per week, generally 9am-4:30pm, must be willing to work weekends, must be available from May 6 to August 31. \$14.50 to \$16.00 per hour depending on experience and duties.
