

Canadian Academic Performance Scholarship (CAPS) Program

Introduction

Quest University Canada is committed to providing a Liberal Arts & Sciences education of the highest quality for Canadian undergraduates. The Canadian Academic Performance Scholarship (CAPS) Program provides an automatic \$10,000 scholarship to all Canadian citizens and permanent residents who apply with an 80% average equivalent or above and are accepted into Quest as a full-time student. CAPS recipients who subsequently drop below the 80% threshold as detailed on their official final (graduation) transcript may have their award revoked.

Averages are calculated from **all academic courses in the final two years of high school**. A list of qualified courses is included below. This list excludes career education courses, physical and health education courses, faith-based courses, skills-based courses, or courses in applied design and technology.

Academic course criteria by province and territory:

BC, Yukon

Academic Grade 11 or 12 courses.

Alberta, NWT, Nunavut

Academic 30 and 20 level course. For Alberta Provincial Exams the blended mark will be used to calculate your average.

Saskatchewan

Academic 30-level and 20-level courses.

Manitoba

Academic 30 and 40 "S" level courses.

Ontario

Academic U and M level Grade 11 and 12 courses.

Quebec

Secondary 5 (500 level) Academic courses and at least one year of CEGEP. CEGEP requirements include: courses in the 603 series, 330 series, 601, 602, 607 to 616 series, 560 series, 510 and 520 series, 550 series, 101, 202, 203, and 201 series.

New Brunswick

Academic grade 11 (3) and grade 12 (4) level courses

PEI

Academic 500 and 600 level courses.

Nova Scotia

Academic Grade 11 and 12 courses.

Newfoundland & Labrador

Academic 2000, 3000, and 4000 level courses.

For students applying with the International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma, a score of **29/42** is required to qualify.
