Years 1 and 2: Foundation Program

- First 2 blocks in 1st year are Cornerstone and Rhetoric and the last block of 2nd year is the Question class
- Students must also take: 3 Life Sciences, 1 Mathematics, 2 Physical Sciences, 3 Social Sciences,
 3 Arts & Humanities, and 1 Language (to be selected from foundation course offerings)

Years 3 and 4: Concentration Program

- 6-11 Focus Courses
 - (selected in consultation with faculty advisor and specifically related to a student's Question)
- 1-4 Experiential Learning blocks (volunteering, internship, research, work experience, etc. and is set up by students)
- 3-5 elective courses (can be any course regardless of a student's focus area)
- Keystone (final block taken)
