International Applicants not holding citizenship from the above countries are required to submit English Language Proficiency scores unless they:

- 1) Have completed full-time academic studies for the last three years in which English was the language of instruction.
- 2) Have spent more than four consecutive years in an English-speaking country.
- 3) Have completed or will complete the International Baccalaureate (IB)
 Diploma by the time of starting studies at Quest

- 4) Have completed GCE Advanced (A) Level English with a final grade of C or better or GCSE/IGCSE/Ordinary (O) Level English Language, English Literature, or English as a Second Language with a final grade of B or better.
- 5) Have completed the Advanced Placement (AP) exam in English with a final grade of 4 or better.

Students meeting the above requirements will be required to submit an English Language Proficiency Waiver Request with their application.
